



# **INSO Circular 11**

27 July 2024

Greetings from the Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (PNRI) and Steering Committee of the **First International Nuclear Science Olympiad (1st INSO)**.

With only a few days remaining before the start of the 1st INSO, may we share the additional information for the students on guides and accommodation.

### • Marshals (Student Guides):

A marshal will be assigned to each competing team during the Olympiad. They will act as "guardians" of the students on behalf of their team leaders. They will guide them in the various activities and see to any other concerns they might have during the time that they are separated from their team leaders.

#### Accommodation:

- As mentioned in <a href="INSO Circular 4">INSO Circular 4</a>, the students will be housed at the Athlete's Village, BCDA, New Clark City, Pampanga. The rooming assignments will be given upon arrival during registration. We have assigned 2 students per room except for those who previously requested individual rooms (with extra payment). We have received a request to have all their students housed together in one room but as much as we want to accommodate this request, the room has only two beds with an extra pullout bed which means only a maximum of 3 students can be accommodated. Please let us know the soonest time possible (latest by July 29, Monday) if you have any preference for 3 of your students occupying one room, otherwise the host will default to 2 students per room.
- o Each room is inclusive of the following items per individual:
  - Simple bath and personal care products for the whole duration of your stay
    - One bath towel (you may bring extra)
    - Shampoo
    - Soap
    - Toothpaste
    - Toothbrush
    - Cotton swabs
    - Toilet rolls

#### Medical Care:

 A team of nurses and doctors from University of the Philippines – Philippine General Hospital (UP-PGH), during all the events of the Olympiad, will be available for any medical concerns. The students are advised to inform their assigned marshals of any concern they may need during their stay. An ambulance is also on stand-by should there be any medical emergency.
